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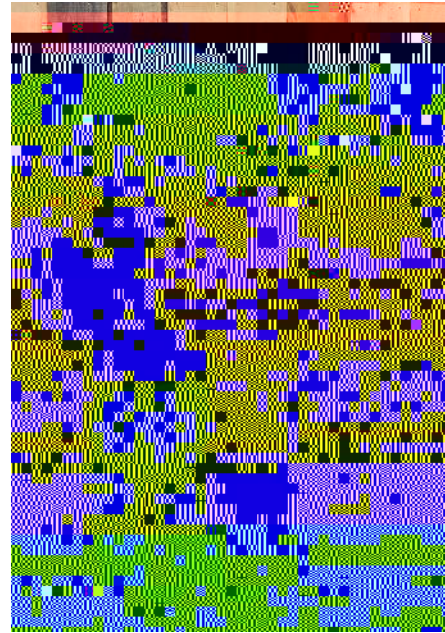
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Students enjoyed a full week of fun during Spring Week, which was held April 15-21.

- Spring Fusion Festival

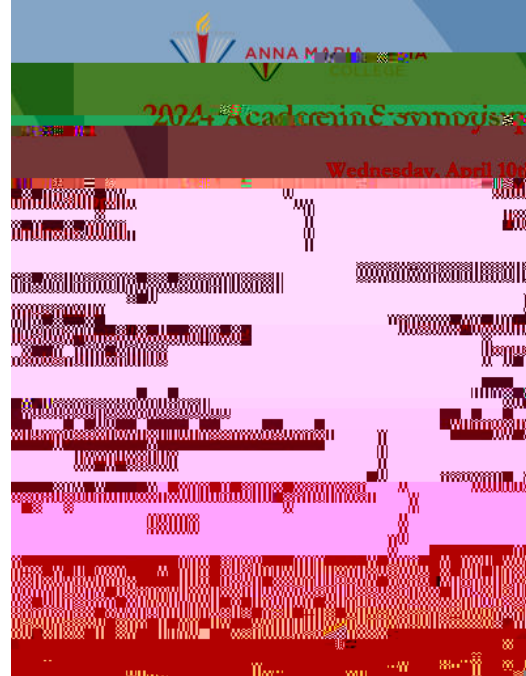


The week was capped off by our **5\* fñ & ' O" fi Ž "'** with music, games, food, and rides!

The students had fun playing memory games, clue, and timed puzzles all while enjoying snacks and laughs with the staff of the Academic Coaching Center.

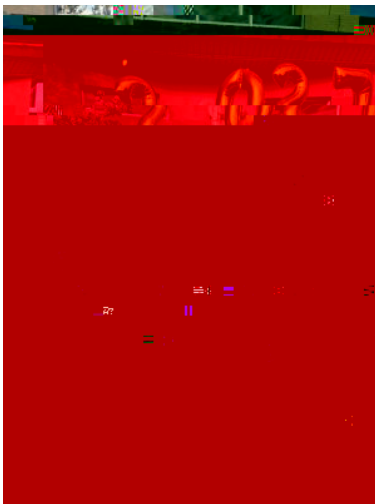
