
1. How long are the class periods?

In most cases, classes are offered on Monday-Wednesday-Friday OR Tuesday-Thursday. Most MWF classes are held for 50 minutes, and T/R classes are held for 1 hour and 15 minutes

2. Who is my advisor(s) and where will I find him/her/them?

Students are assigned an advisor based on their major. You can find your advisor in your admissions portal if you are a new student or it is located in WebAVC for returning students

3. How many credits do I take?

To be considered a full-time

student, you

must

take at least 12 credits per semester. For students with a previous semester of 12 or more credits, a minimum of 9 credits is required. For students with 6-11 credits, a minimum of 10 credits is required. For students with 0-5 credits, a minimum of 11 credits is required. For students with 0-3 credits, a minimum of 12 credits is required. For students with 4-5 credits, a minimum of 11 credits is required. For students with 6-7 credits, a minimum of 10 credits is required. For students with 8-9 credits, a minimum of 9 credits is required.
